MARCH VOTERS' MEETING SUMMARY On March 17, a regularly scheduled voters meeting included the usual reports from administrative boards, pastors, treasurer, committees, and auxiliaries. Items of new business featured the planning calendar for 2024 and numerous upcoming events. The voters also reviewed proposed edits to the Bylaws regarding the call process, the duties of an Assistant Treasurer, the formation of an Insurance Review Committee every five years, adding the presidential responsibility of submitting current Bylaws to the district, and the specification of an executive committee to act on behalf of the church in emergency situations. Approval of these changes will be part of the May voters meeting. An interest group (primarily members of Trinity and Redeemer) is exploring the possibility of a Lutheran High School in Springfield; voters approved two representative positions from Faith for a possible future planning committee. These representatives would be responsible for reporting to Church Council and to Voters, the latter being the decision-making body in any future planning for a school and how those plans might involve Faith, Springfield. Lastly, the voters decided to issue a call to Pastor James King, currently serving at Immanuel Lutheran Church, Gaylord, Minnesota.
