**NO THURSDAY MORNING BIBLE CLASS THIS WEEK (OCT 10)** Pastor Jerry Markel leads a Bible class on Thursday mornings at 9 AM. This class meets in the Fellowship Hall. **WHAT LUTHERANS BELIEVE STARTS TODAY** Pastor Dave Benson will again be teaching an **8-week section** of this class on **Sunday mornings at 9:45 AM** in the Fellowship Hall, **beginning Sunday, October 6th**. This class is designed for adults and older youth who have not been confirmed in the Lutheran Church but are interested in joining Faith as official members. **THIS TIME, ESTABLISHED MEMBERS ARE ALSO INVITED TO JOIN THIS CLASS AS A REFRESHER.** The class covers the "Six Chief Parts" of Lutheran teaching from Luther's Small Catechism. **COMPARATIVE RELIGIONS: CATHOLICISM** This study, co-led by Cody and Amy Jeffries, began Sunday, September 22nd in the Gathering Room. In this seven-week installment of a longer series, we will compare and contrast Lutheranism with the denomination from which Martin Luther originally broke ties. In later installments of this Comparative Religions study, we will discuss how Lutheranism differs from other faiths, including Islam and Mormonism. **There will be no class on October 6<sup>th</sup>. Instead, please attend the first session of the “What Lutherans Believe” class in the Fellowship Hall. Pastor Dave will be showing a video about Martin Luther and leading a discussion.**
